This Memorandum of Agreement is made to inform that

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| 1. Prof. Dr. Akin Duli, M.A. | : Dean of Faculty of Cultural Sciences Universitas Hasanuddin (UNHAS), in this agreement as the representative of English Department, located on 1st Floor, Faculty of Cultural Sciences Jl. Perintis Kemerdekaan KM 10 Kota Makassar 90245 Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as FIRST PARTY). |
| 2. Dr. Gary Bonar | : Head of School of Education, Monash University, Australia, (hereinafter referred to as SECOND PARTY). |

Furthermore, FIRST PARTY and SECOND PARTY are referred to collectively as THE PARTIES, and individually as THE PARTY. THE PARTIES have previously considered the followings:

1. that the FIRST PARTY is the Dean of Faculty of Cultural Sciences, Universitas Hasanuddin (UNHAS) (FIB, UNHAS);
2. that the SECOND PARTY is the Head of School of Education, Monash University., (hereafter referred as Monash University that will cooperate with the FIRST PARTY; and that THE PARTIES support each other to have cooperation on establishing **Research Collaboration and Joint Publication**
3. THE PARTIES agree to have cooperation on establishing **Research Collaboration and Joint Publication**

ARTICLE 1

OBJECTIVES

(1) This Memorandum of Agreement is made as a guideline for THE PARTIES in establishing Research Collaboration and Joint Publication.

(2) The objectives of this Memorandum of Agreement are:

- a. Involving lecturers of School of Education, Monash University in establishing Research Collaboration and Joint Publication.
- b. Involving Lecturer of English Department in establishing Research Collaboration and Joint Publication.

ARTICLE 2

SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

THE PARTIES agree to establish English Teachers Professional Certification on TESOL (Teaching of English for Speakers of Other Languages) to optimize a partnership with mutual benefit. The details of implementation will be further arranged in an implementation agreement for the following activities:

- a. Involving lecturers of School of Education, Monash University in establishing Research Collaboration and Joint Publication.
- b. Involving Lecturer of English Department in establishing Research Collaboration and Joint Publication.

ARTICLE 3

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

- (1) Rights/Obligations of the FIRST PARTY has the right to provide suggestions and/or input in relation to the implementation of activities based on this Memorandum of Agreement.
- (2) Rights/Obligations of the SECOND PARTY has the right to use data and information with the permission of both PARTY in connection with the activities in this Memorandum of Agreement.

ARTICLE 4

COST

- (1). The cost needed for the implementation of the program of establishing Research Collaboration and Joint Publication agreed in this Memorandum of Agreement will be determined and borne together by THE PARTIES.

ARTICLE 5 DURATION

- (1) This Memorandum of Agreement is applicable for three years since the signing of this Memorandum of Agreement, and it can be extended or terminated based on a written agreement between THE PARTIES.
- (2) Intention to terminate this Memorandum of Agreement should be communicated in writing to the other PARTY three months before this Memorandum of Agreement expires.
- (3) Termination of this Memorandum of Agreement due to a written request or other reasons will not cause the termination of activities in this Memorandum of Agreement until THE PARTIES fulfil their obligations.

PASAL 6 FORCE MAJEUR

- (1) This Memorandum of Agreement may automatically be terminated or cancelled in the following condition:
 - a. changes of regulations or government policies that result in impossibility to implement this Memorandum of Agreement
 - b. force majeure conditions including fire accidents, natural disaster, earthquake, general strikes, riots, and other similar conditions due to natural causes that cannot be avoided
 - c. bankruptcy
- (2) THE PARTY that get the impact of any condition in point (1).b and (1).c should inform the OTHER PARTY one month at the latest since the occurrence of the condition.
- (3) Force majeure conditions and bankruptcy mentioned in point (1) should be proved by an authorized institution.

PASAL 7 MISCELLANEOUS

- (1) In case of different perspectives in implementing this Memorandum of Agreement, THE PARTIES will solve the problem with good intention and through an amicable way.
- (2) Things not yet regulated in this Memorandum of Agreement will be arranged later in an addendum made based on agreement between THE PARTIES, and the addendum cannot be separated from this Memorandum of Agreement.

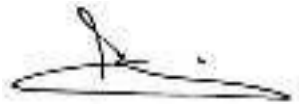
