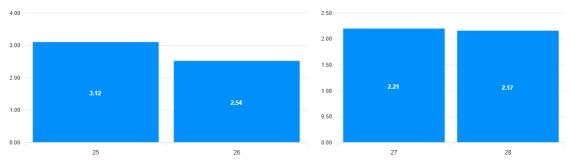

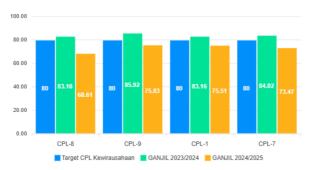

4. Analysis and Reflection

Analysis and reflection

Analysis

1. Significant Performance Decline from Superior Level

Data analysis shows a significant and overall decline in performance in the ODD semester 2024/2025. The performance of courses which in the previous period (ODD 2023/2024) was very superior with all CPLs exceeding the target of 80 (average score 84), has now fallen substantially, with all CPLs below the target.

2. There is an Area of the Sharpest Decline

Even though the decline occurred in all areas, a more detailed analysis shows that there is a point of the most severe decline. CPL-8 experienced the most drastic decline, falling more than 14 points from 83.16 to 68.61. Other CPLs also experienced significant declines, but CPL-8 was the most prominent area of weakness in the last period.

Reflection

1. Indication of Fundamental Changes that Have a Negative Impact

The even decline in all CPLs reflects the high possibility that fundamental changes have occurred that have a negative impact between the two lecture periods, especially because this is a practice-oriented course. This reflection directs suspicion towards systemic factors such as significant changes to the final project design (business plan), assessment criteria, or practitioner involvement that may be less effective than the previous year.

2. The Need for Focused Investigation for Effective Intervention

Data indicating CPL-8 as the most severe area of impairment provides a clear direction for follow-up. The reflection is that improvement efforts should begin with focused investigations of learning or assessment elements specific to CPL-8. By understanding the root of the problem at this weakest point, designed interventions can be more targeted and effective in restoring overall performance.

5. Follow-up Plan

In response to the significant and even decline in CPL achievement in the Entrepreneurship Course, where performance is far from the target of 80, the action plan will focus on changing the RPS. This investigation will specifically review differences in learning methods, project assignment design and assessment criteria. The aim is to rediscover the key elements that drove previous success and re-implement them in order to restore student achievement so that they can consistently exceed the target score of 80.

6. Follow-up results on the previous semester's evaluation

Following up on the findings of the previous semester evaluation for the Entrepreneurship Course, which showed a significant decline in performance from superior level (average 84 in Odd 2023/2024) to below target level (average 73 in Odd 2024/2025) with CPL-8 as the point of sharpest decline, an intervention plan that focuses on comparative analysis of practical aspects and evaluation has been implemented. The importance of consistency in the design of project tasks and practical assessment criteria, and recommends that standards from high performance periods be maintained to maintain quality.
